

A winter ascent of Mount Toubkal and the souks of Marrakech



A 10 day trip including an 8 Day trek through the Berber villages of the High Atlas Mountains of Morocco culminating in an ascent of Mount Toubkal the highest peak in North Africa

Staying overnight in Marrakesh we have an opportunity to visit the souks (bazaars) of this ancient trading post of the Sahara desert. Then driving out through the lush valleys we travel up into the High Atlas Mountains to begin our trek through the Berber villages towards Jebel Toubkal (4167m). Staying in mountain huts with cook teams to keep us well fed and watered and having horses to carry all the baggage there is plenty of time to acclimatize to the altitude and prepare for the ascent of the mountain.

What's involved?

- 8 Days trekking around the Berber villages in the High Atlas Mountains with a winter ascent of Mount Toubkal (North Africa's highest mountain)
- 2/3 Nights in a three star traditional Moroccan Riad (Hotel) on a half board basis
- Final night meal in Marrakech
- An opportunity to visit the souks in Marrakech

Outline Itinerary

Day one	Flight to Marrakech
Day two	To Imlil, overnight in Guest house
Day three – six	Acclimatization trekking.
Day seven	To Mountain refugio
Day eight	Summit Toubcal and back to Imlil
Day nine	In Marrakech
Day ten	Return to UK

NB; This expedition can also be used as a practice DofE expedition

What's included?

- All food costs (breakfast, packed lunches and main meals)
- Horses to carry main baggage
- Any bunk house/camping costs
- All in-country travel costs
- Two experienced and qualified British walking guides with first aid qualifications.
- Local English speaking mountain guide
- All technical mountaineering equipment (Ice Axe and Crampons if required)
- A detailed Itinerary (which will be issued nearer the departure date)
- Equipment lists
- School based briefings for parents and pupils
- Further rest day walks/sightseeing opportunities

What's not included

- Personal spending monies allow £50 max
- Tips (Individuals should allow at least £10 each for tips)
- Additional Café costs and or confectionary/soft drinks
- Participants should allow £10 - £20 for one meal in Marrakech, this gives the opportunity to organise their sight seeing day as they want.
